She therefore selected Chateau Toots, an Alabama premier bed and breakfast nestled at the edge of Lay Lake.

Celia worked with Florist and Event Planner Mandy Majerik of Hothouse Design Studio to select nature-inspired hues of chartreuse green (grass), espresso brown (earth),

and tiffany blue (sky) for her predominant color palette. Bridesmaids Elliott Mayson and Marlow Wilson wear Alvina Valenta dresses by Victoria McMillan, provided by Bella Couture. Elliott's Blue Moon duet satin teal-length dress features an illusion crumb-catcher neckline with an empire waist. Marlow wears a chocolate charmeuse strapless dress. Their bouquets, elegantly fashioned with blue hydrangea and accented with miller, complement Celia's hand-tied bouquet of rare floral varieties. Jewelry by Erin Cole.
